Title 17 (CCR) § 2500 Reporting to the Local Health Authority and § 2508. Reporting by Schools

"It shall be the duty of anyone in charge of a public or private school, kindergarten, boarding school, or day nursery to report at once to the local health officer the presence or suspected presence of any of the communicable diseases."

Suspected cases or outbreaks of communicable diseases such as **chickenpox**, **measles**, **pertussis**, **and meningitis** must be reported by school or pre-kindergarten personnel to the local health department. Note that some of these diseases must be reported immediately by phone. Please do not wait until the child returns to pre-kindergarten or school before contacting the local health department.
