## **Warming Zones to Open in San Joaquin County**

(San Joaquin County, CA) - According to the National Weather Service, San Joaquin County residents are anticipated to experience temperatures below freezing over the next few days. As a proactive measure, the County's Human Services Agency has designated eight Community Centers as Warming Zones that will open today. Warming Zones provide a heated facility to offer people relief from the cold. Individuals who do not have ready access to a warm environment, particularly the elderly and young children, should use the warming zones. Hours of operation are Monday - Friday from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm.

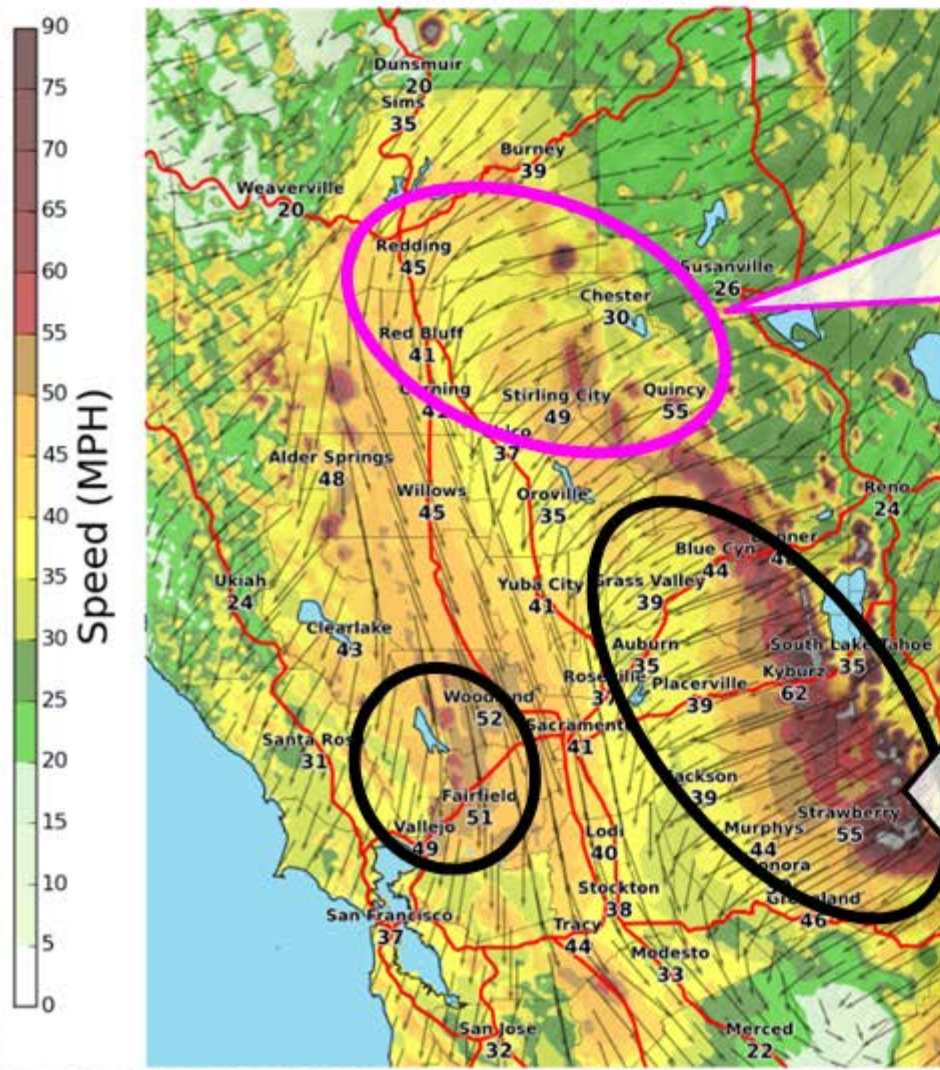

### What's Expected Later

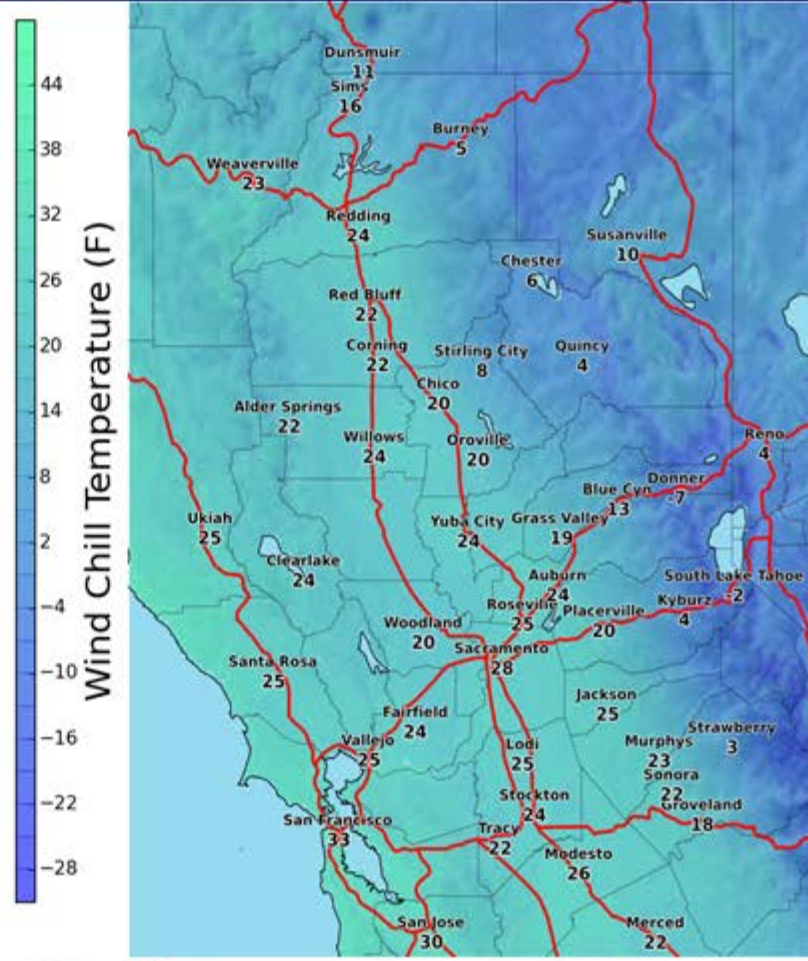
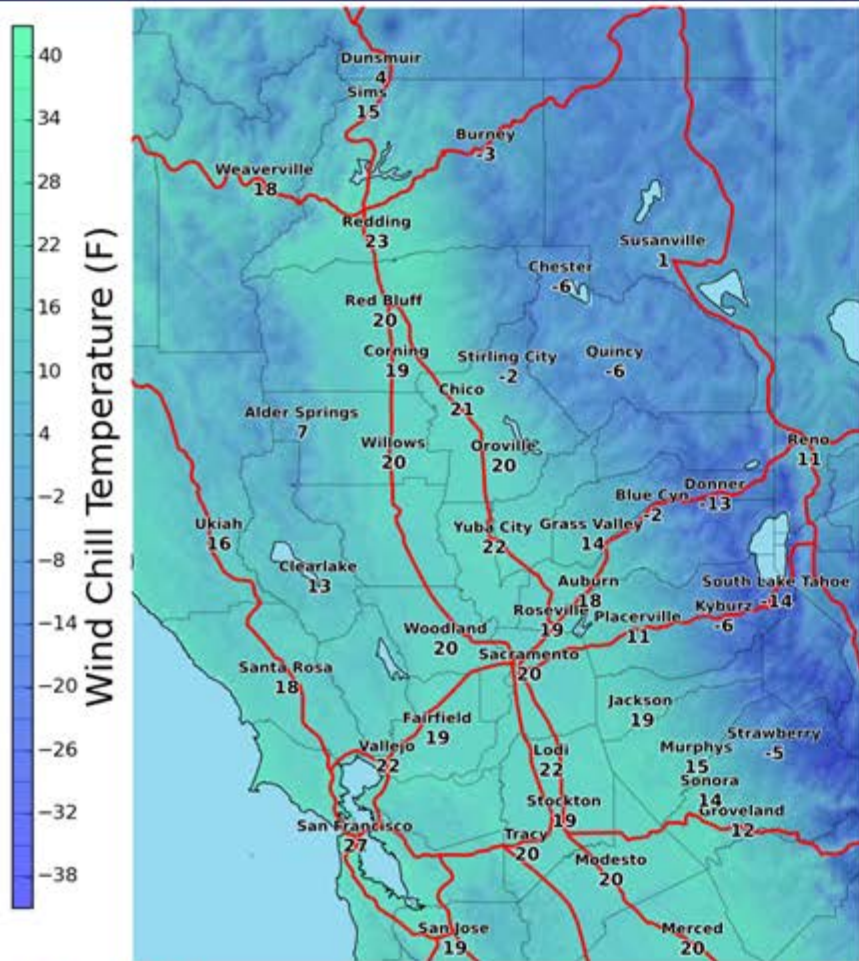
- ✓ Delta/Foothills: Wind gusts 45-60 mph

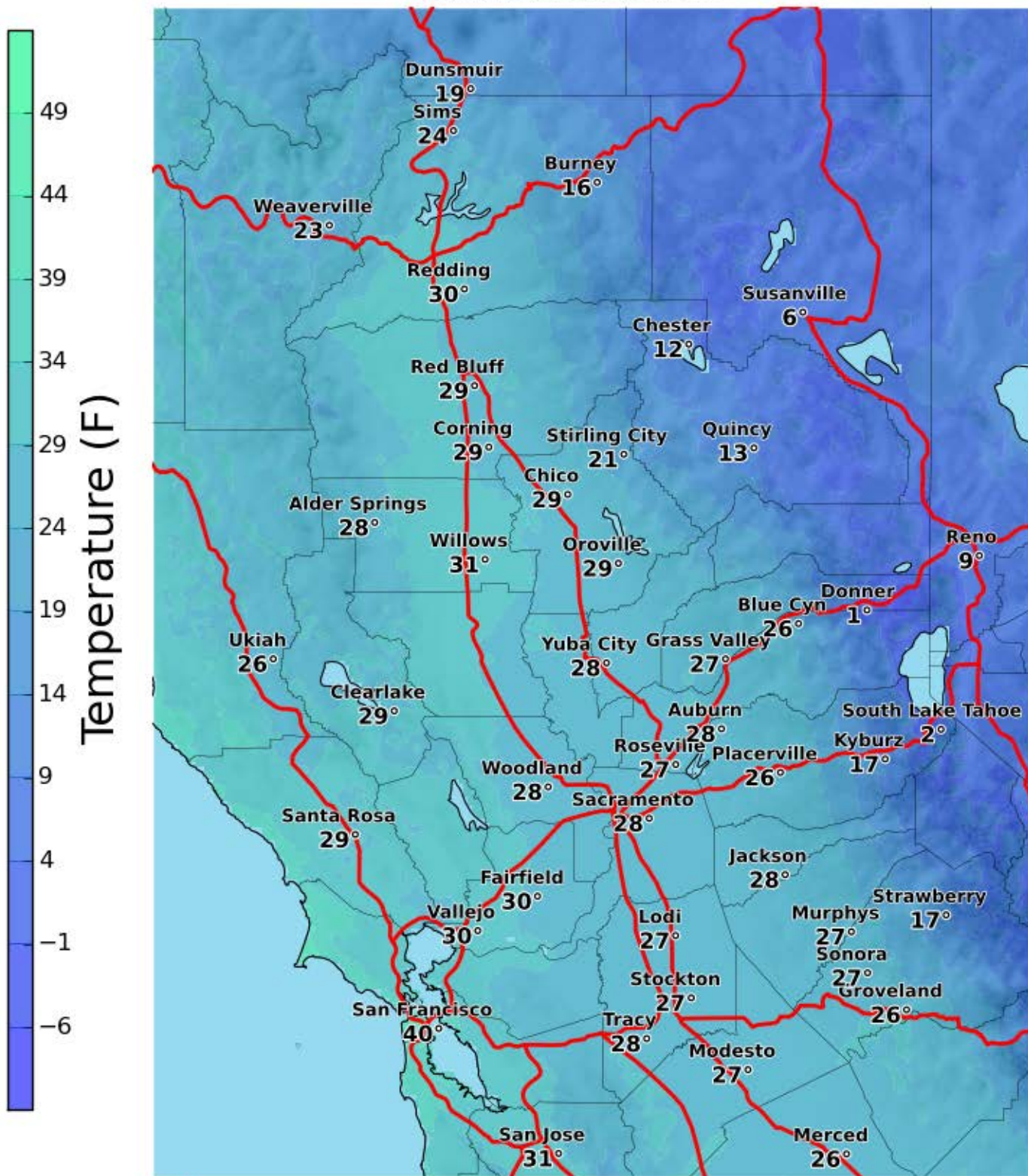
