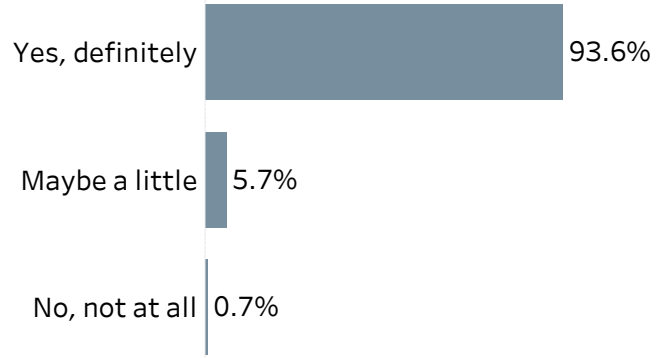

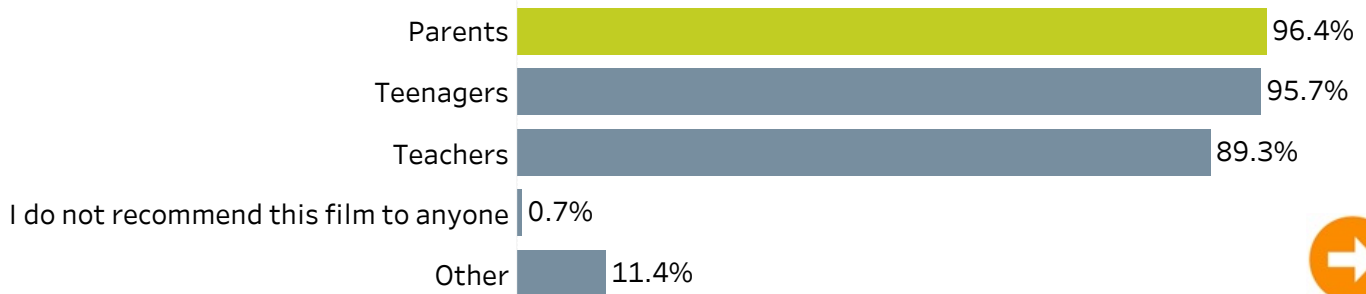
How helpful do you think the film is in teaching people about fentanyl? (n=139)



Do you feel motivated to talk to others about the dangers of fentanyl? (n=140)

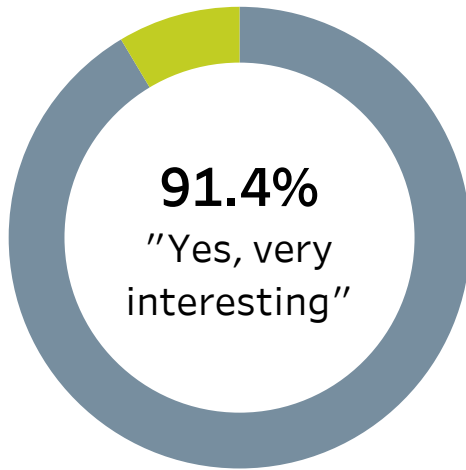


Who would you recommend this film to? (n=140)

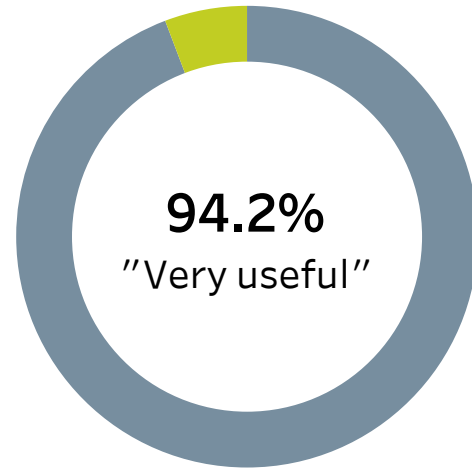
